2023 AGREEMENT FOR RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

I request permission (or for my child, named below) to participate in cross-country riding and foxhunting with the OLD NORTH BRIDGE HOUNDS.

I fully understand that cross-country horseback riding and foxhunting (which includes riding over fences, other obstacles, and steep and rough terrain) are very dangerous activities. I wish to participate in these activities (or allow my child to participate) knowing they are dangerous. I accept and assume all the risks of injury (including death) to me, my child, or my property.

In exchange for me (or my child) being permitted to participate in these activities, for myself, (my child, my child's heirs, guardians, and legal representatives), my heirs, guardians, and legal representatives, I release and agree not to make any claim of any kind against the OLD NORTH BRIDGE HOUNDS, or its Masters, officers, directors, members, employees, or guests; or any landowners, landholders, or other persons making property available for the OLD NORTH BRIDGE HOUNDS, for any injury (including death) to me (or my child), or any damage to my property whether for anyone's negligence or not, or any other cause, arising out of my participation (or my child's participation) in these dangerous horseback riding, foxhunting, or related activities; and I also agree if anyone makes any claims because of any injury to me (or my child) (including death), or for any other damage to my property, I will keep all those released by this agreement free of any damages or costs because of these claims.
